
Charles and Ray Eames developed a toy elephant made of plywood in 1945. Manufactured in recycled post-industrial plastic, the Eames Elephant RE can now be enjoyed by the target group for which it was originally intended: children – whether as an indoor-outdoor toy or simply as an attractive object for a child's bedroom.

The Eames Elephant also comes in plywood as well as in the scaled-down version Eames Elephant (small) RE made of recycled plastic.

- **Material:** dyed-through recycled polypropylene from industrial waste, 100% recyclable, matt finish.

 **Outdoor use:** suitable for utilisation outdoors on a temporary or seasonal basis, following care instructions. After prolonged exposure to the elements, clean and store away in a dry, sheltered place to ensure lasting use and avoid any deterioration in appearance.
